NCRA partners with Excelsior College Members can pursue higher education at reduced cost

In addition, tuition costs for NCRA members and their spouses or domestic partners are offered at a reduced cost compared to other enrollees.

NCRA members or their families can register now for the fall semester.

"Professional development has taken on greater importance in recent years as all levels of government look to address the skills gap," said Dr. John Ebersole, president of Excelsior College. "By partnering with Excelsior, NCRA can provide their members access to a quality, affordable education and develop their member's current and future workforce needs."
