PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, throughout history, the spoken word has been transcribed into text to ensure its preservation; and
- WHEREAS, scribes were present when our nation's founding fathers drafted the Declaration of Independence and the Bill of Rights, and President Abraham Lincoln later entrusted scribes to record the Emancipation Proclamation; and
- WHEREAS, scribes have long been entrusted with accurately recording such information for official use and posterity; and
- WHEREAS, now known as court reporters and captioners, these scribes play key roles in courtrooms and communities across the Hoosier State; and
- WHEREAS, in recognition of their important work, it is appropriate to commend our state's court reporters and captioners for their noble efforts;
